Hi Philip,

Yes we have.

We provide the following comment:

1. The water balance analysis focusses more on runoff mitigation than infiltration. Use of roof leader discharge to landscaped areas does not provide much infiltration benefit since most of the water is lost to evapotranspiration. Given the limited potential for infiltration in this particular neighbourhood, roof leader discharge directed to a swale underlain by clear stone should be considered. This should encourage infiltration and still allow surface drainage.
