Subject: Richmond Hill Mobility Accessibility Foundation Grant Request

Purpose:

To report on the grant request from Richmond Hill Mobility Accessibility Foundation.

- b) That a grant in the amount of \$50,000 be allocated from the Disabled Parking Reserve.

Background:

In December 2004, Council approved By-law No. 258-04 for the establishment of the Disabled Parking Reserve. Since that time annual allocations of 50% of the revenue from disabled parking offenses have been made to this reserve on an annual basis to support mobility and accessibility initiatives in the Town. The allocations to Richmond Hill Mobility Accessibility Foundation for the two prior years are as follows:

- 2016 was \$50,000
- 2017 was \$50,000

Schedule "C" in Appendix "A" provides a summary of how the 2017 grant funds were used. For 2018 the Richmond Hill Mobility Accessibility Foundation has requested a grant in the amount of \$50,000. The summary below identifies how the 2018 grant request will support mobility initiatives in the Town:

| Assistive Devices Program | 12,000 |
| Recreation Programs | 18,000 |
| Total Grant Request | \$50,000 |

Financial/Staffing/Other Implications:

For 2018 the Richmond Hill Mobility Accessibility Foundation has requested a grant in the amount \$50,000. Approval of this amount will leave a balance of \$147,100 in the Disabled Parking Reserve for future mobility and accessibility initiatives.

Relationship to the Strategic Plan:

Providing funding to the Richmond Hill Mobility Foundation is in keeping with the Strategic Plan Goal of Stronger Connections in Richmond Hill and more specifically providing, "opportunities and places for people to connect and get involved" and making, "physical connections in the community". By supporting the Foundation so they may purchase more equipment to aid people with disabilities, the Town is assisting in the removal of barriers to effective participation for all people in the community. This funding will also increase accessibility for those people with disabilities.

Conclusion:

That the Richmond Hill Mobility Accessibility Foundation grant request (provided in Appendix "A") be received and that the allocation of \$50,000 of grant funds be approved and allocated from the Disabled Parking Reserve.
