Dear Ms. Trivino:

I am writing in response to your correspondence forawrded to the Honourable Pablo Rodriguez, Minister of Canadian Heritage and Multiculturalism, requesting information on Latin American Heritage Month in Canada. Minister Rodriguez appreciates your taking the time to write on this matter. Please excuse the delay in my reply.

In February 2016, the late Honourable Tobias C. Enverga Jr. introduced Bill S-218, *An Act Respecting Latin American Heritage Month*. Bill S-218 sought to designate October, in each and every year, as Latin American Heritage Month in Canada. The Government of Canada supported Bill S-218, which received Royal Assent on June 21, 2018.

The Act does not mandate other levels of government to observe Latin American Heritage Month. However, a special commemorative date or event can be recognized by any public body, including municipal, provincial or territorial governments, international bodies such as the United Nations, private associations, cultural groups or religious institutions

Funding opportunities are available to community organizations for events and celebrations through the Community Support, Multiculturalism, and Anti-Racism Initiatives Program.
