To consider appointing a Chief Building Official for the City of Richmond Hill and to remove and/or appoint Building Inspectors pursuant to the *Building Code Act* and By-law No. 55-19 to reflect staffing changes (i.e. departures and/or hires) within the Regulatory Services Division.

Background:

Legislative Authority for the Appointment of Building Officials:

The *Building Code Act, 1992* assigns responsibility for enforcement of building construction legislation to the Council of the City of Richmond Hill. Further, the *Act* requires Council to appoint a Chief Building Official and such Inspectors as are necessary for the enforcement of the Act in the City of Richmond Hill.

Significant Proposed Changes to the Building By-law:

APPOINTMENT OF THE CHIEF BUILDING OFFICIAL AND BUILDING OFFICIALS FOR ENFORCEMENT OF THE BUILDING CODE ACT

The Chief Building Official, Deputy Chief Building Officials and Inspectors are appointed by Council pursuant to By-law No. 55-19, being a by-law made pursuant to Subsection 3(2) of the *Building Code Act*.

Staff changes have occurred that require that Schedule B of By-law No. 55-19 be updated/amended.

Financial/Staffing/Other Implications:

This report has no significant financial or staffing implications for the Regulatory Services Division.

Relationship to the Strategic Plan:

The administrative and enforcement roles of the Regulatory Services Division support the Strategic Plan Goals of Stronger Connections in Richmond Hill by maintaining a safe community.

Conclusion:

The City of Richmond Hill continues to administer and enforce the Ontario Building Code and the *Building Code Act, 1992* in accordance with provincial legislation.
