Corporate and Financial Services

Community Services

- Insufficient covered space to seasonally store rolling stock
- Weather adversely impacts equipment life cycles e.g., hydraulics & components

- Project Phasing Option
 - Yr. 1 Civil & underground services (\$10.45M)
 - Yr. 2 Frost free building & refurbishments (\$11.45M)







Parks grounds maintenance equipment

Insufficient indoor storage to secure equipment. Off season storage at Richmond Green agricultural barn.





Seasonal tire storage

Large tractor and heavy equipment rims and tires are secured in areas that could otherwise be used for vehicle and equipment parking. Inventory is exposed to extreme weather resulting in shorter life cycles.





Watermain pipe, valves & hydrants

Inventory should be secured indoors where exposure to dust, critters and weather is limited. The presence of deleterious material in watermain can result in adverse test results during the commissioning process.





Parks & waste management inventory

Old and new innovatory is exposed to weather conditions as there is insufficient indoor storage space.





Sports dome sea containers

The sports dome is disassembled every spring and reassembled in the fall annually. Five sea containers are utilized to secure the components.





Traffic, Sign & Christmas Decoration Storage

Three sea containers are used to secure this inventory as there is no indoor space to accommodate it.





Trench Boxes & Trailer Storage

Every available space is utilized to secure materials and supplies.

The addition of 35 new windrow machines has put a strain on yard capacity.
