By-law 108-19

A By-law to authorize Fees or Charges for Certain Services (Tariff of Fees By-law)

Whereas Section 391 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, authorizes the Council of the City of Richmond Hill to pass by-laws for the imposing of fees or changes on any class of persons;

And Whereas Council at its meeting of November 20, 2019 adopted the recommendation of the Budget Committee of the Whole at its meeting of October 22, 2019 in SRCFS.19.036 pertaining to new and amended fees as part of the annual Tariff of Fees By-law.

Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of The City of Richmond Hill enacts as follows:

- 1. That By-law No. 108-19 be effective as of January 1, 2020, unless otherwise noted.
- 2. That By-law No. 65-18 be repealed effective December 31, 2019.

Financial

Tariff of Fees

Article 1

General Provisions

1.1 Fees Payable

Any person who makes an application to, or a request for services of the City of Richmond Hill or who enters into an agreement with the City of Richmond Hill or obtains an approval from the City of Richmond Hill, or who purchases any good or service from the City of Richmond Hill, in respect of things or matters set out in this Chapter shall pay to the Treasurer of the City of Richmond Hill the applicable fee set out herein and, unless otherwise provided for by this or another relevant Chapter, such fees or charges are not refundable and are payable upon the person making such application or request or purchase.

1.2 Additional Charges

Any person who makes an application to, or a request for services of the City of Richmond Hill or who enters into an agreement with the City of Richmond Hill or obtains an approval from the City of Richmond Hill, or who purchases any good or service from the City of Richmond Hill, in respect of things or matters set out in this Chapter shall, in addition to the fee set out in Section 1.1, pay to the Treasurer of the City of Richmond Hill all costs incurred by the City of Richmond Hill in retaining outside legal services directly related to that agreement, approval or purchase and , unless otherwise provided for by this or another relevant Chapter, such additional charges are not refundable and are to be secured, to the satisfaction of the City Solicitor or his designate, upon the earlier of the agreement, as the case may be.

1.3 Duplication of Fees Payable

Notwithstanding anything in Sections 1.1 or 1.2 to the contrary where, in the opinion of the City Solicitor or his designate, in his or her sole discretion, there may be duplication between the fee and/or charge provided for in Section 1.1 and the costs or charges set out in Section 1.2, the fee set out in 1.1 may be reduced to take into account any such duplication by an amount as determined by the City Solicitor or his designate.

1.4 Indexing of Fees Payable

Fees imposed pursuant to this By-law shall be adjusted annually, without amendment to this By-law, commencing on the first day of January in the year following the enactment of this By-Law and every subsequent year, up to a maximum rate that is in accordance with the August to December change in the Statistics Canada Consumer Price Index – Toronto.

1.5 Fees Waived or Reduced

The City of Richmond Hill reserves the right to waive or reduce fees as set out in this Chapter, subject to legislative restrictions.

1.6 Delegations of Authorities

The authorities to determine the rate of the annual adjustment of fees pursuant to Section 1.4 and to waive or reduce fees pursuant Section 1.5 to is delegated to:

- (a) the Commissioner of Community Services with respect to those fees set out in Schedules "A", "B", "C", "D" and "E";
- (b) the Commissioner of Corporate & Financial Services with respect to those fees set out in Schedules "F" and "G";
- (c) the Commissioner of Environment & Infrastructure with respect to those fees set out in Schedule "H" and "I";

- (d) the City Manager with respect to those fees set out in Schedule "J"; and
- (e) the Commissioner of Planning & Regulatory Services with respect to those fees set out in Schedules "K", "L", "M" and "N".

1.6 Schedules

Schedules A – N shall form part of this Chapter.

Article 2 Repeal

2.1 By-laws – previous

By-law 65-18 is hereby repealed and replaced with By-law 108-19, effective for services rendered or applicable on or after January 1, 2020 unless otherwise noted.
