I am writing this letter to express my concern about the proposed motion that Councillor DiPaola will be putting forth this week to move the meeting times for Council and Committee of the Whole meetings to 9:30 a.m. permanently rather than previous start time of 7:30 p.m. The City of Richmond Hill is entering a period of rapid change and growth and as a longtime resident of over twenty years, I have a real interest and desire to be informed and involved in what happens to the City. If meeting times are moved to 9:30 a.m. on weekdays, then I will not be able to attend any of them since. I work full time during the day. I feel this is the situation for the majority of taxpayers and voters in Richmond Hill who are not retirees - that is, they are employed during daytime hours and consequently cannot attend any meetings if they are held during the daytime period.
