Members of our community have discussed a safe Pedestrian Crossing with various authorities on several occasions and we understand that Planning and Regulatory Services have investigated and since in its assessment a controlled crossing is warranted a recommendation has been made for its implementation.

For those of us that call 22 Clarissa Drive our home, owing to significant increases in traffic volumes on Clarissa Drive the ability to cross the street safely continues to become more difficult. The problem is exacerbated because the majority of our occupants are senior citizens that need to cross Clarissa Drive to access the shopping facilities and many are affected with reduced or impaired mobility.

As the problem will only become worse with further development in this area of Richmond Hill, much of which is in progress, the need will become more critical and to safeguard vulnerable citizens we urge you to proceed with this safety measure promptly.
