Subject: Civic Precinct Lands – Incremental Maintenance Requirements

On February 25, 2020, the Capital Sustainability Steering Committee resolved:

- That the use of the Civic Precinct lands at the southwest corner of Yonge Street and Major Mackenzie Drive be determined by the Official Plan Review;
- That subject to the appropriate zoning, the lands be used as passive parkland until such time as the Official Plan Review is concluded; and
- That staff report back to the Sustainability Committee in Q2 2020 on incremental capital and operating requirements to maintain the Civic Precinct lands as passive parkland.

This memo responds to the request that staff report back on incremental capital and operating requirements. Currently, the City maintains the Civic Precinct lands as passive parkland. There are no additional costs to continue maintaining the site in its current condition.
