I oppose the request for increased density at this time. The current road infrastructure along Yonge and Carville/16th Ave cannot handle additional volume. The creation of the bus lanes and the increased volume at select streets to turn/uturn currently impede traffic flow.

Incremental volume will only make it worse. The existing situation is so bad, that north/south overflow volume has to be dangerously absorbed by Avenue/Person, which is filled with families, children on bikes, parks and an elementary school. Density should only be added once the infrastructure is prepared to handle it.
