5.0 Councillor Chan – Noise By-law Review

Whereas there have been reported incidents regarding complaints about excessive noise levels that raise issues in enforcement due to the lack of an objective and enforceable definition of noise level;

Whereas the Noise Bylaw permits applications for exemption that are processed without consultation or notification in advance to the local Councillor and to the residents in the neighbourhood in which the exemption, if approved, would be impacted;

Now Therefore Be It Resolved that Council direct staff to undertake a comprehensive review of the Noise Bylaw to improve the By-law for increased effectiveness in enforcement, the process for noise exemption approval, and to report to Council before summer 2015 with recommendations on implementation on any identified improvements.
