By-Law 4-21

A By-law to amend the Administrative Penalties By-law 69-16 to
include designated Sign By-law 52-09 offences

Whereas on February 11, 2019, Council of the Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill (“Council”) enacted an amendment to By-law 69-16 that established and administrative monetary penalty system (“AMPS”) for parking infractions, and By-law 69-16 has since been expanded so that the AMPS may also apply to promote compliance with any by-law passed pursuant to the *Municipal Act, 2001*;

And Whereas on March 24, 2021, Council of the City of Richmond Hill adopted the recommendations of staff report SRCS.21.07 amending the Sign By-law 52-09, as amended, to provide for enforcement of designated offences using AMPS;

Now Therefore The Council Of The Corporation Of The City Of Richmond Hill Enacts As Follows:

That Schedule A of the Administrative Penalties By-law 69-16, as amended, be further amended by adding the following as Table 7:
