Since the construction started we the residents of 185 feel the danger to drive out of our entrance since sometime there are huge trucks and cement mixing machines parked facing the east side, whereas cars parked facing the west side curb blocking the view and narrowing the lane for 2 sided traffic.

The traffic load is already heavy on Redmaple rd. School traffic, plus the Go train time rush and vehicles from atleast 400 hundred residents moving in the new buildings (20 story towers),

It will be heavy load on all the facilities name it, electrical, water and sewage, community center and the school itself.

It's a nightmare even to consider the proposal of 4 towers of 18 to 30 story high.
