By-Law 74-21

A By-Law to authorize the use of voting and vote counting equipment, namely optical scan vote tabulators, for municipal and school board elections and by-elections

Whereas clause 42(1)(a) of the *Municipal Elections Act*, 1996, S.O. 1996, c.32, as amended (the “Act”), authorizes the Council of a local municipality to pass by-laws authorizing the use of voting and vote-counting equipment such as voting machines, voting recorders or optical scanning vote tabulators;

And Whereas Council at its meeting on June 9, 2021 adopted the recommendations in Staff Report SRCFS.21.025, authorizing the use of optical scanning vote tabulators for municipal and school board elections and by-elections held in the City of Richmond Hill pursuant to the Act;

Now Therefore The Council Of The Corporation Of The City Of Richmond Hill Enacts As Follows:

1. That, pursuant to clause 42(1)(a) of the Act, Council authorizes the use of voting and vote-counting equipment, namely optical scanning vote tabulators, for all municipal and school board elections and by-elections held in the City of Richmond Hill pursuant to the Act.
