As a Richmond Hill resident I would like to express my disgust with respect to the exemption request from Mr Perreli for his Enviro Day Event (item 13.2 of the Agenda) which I would like it to be included in public records. It's very insulting to tell the residents that the event is a free exchange and then expect it to be funded by Richmond hill tax payers. Mr Perreli MUST follow the Council Event Policy which says Council-led Events are not to be directly funded from any City budget. (Policy Principles Section 2) and based on that he MUST look for another source to pay his account deficit and not from OUR Tax Supported Reserve.
