

The Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill

By-Law 16-22

A By-law to Permanently Stop-up and Close a portion of Aida Place,
Part of Aida Place, Plan M-807, designated as Parts 1 – 4, Plan 65R-39646,
Richmond Hill

Whereas Council at its meeting of December 8, 2021 adopted the recommendation pertaining to the stop-up and closure of that portion of Aida Place more particularly described as part of Aida Place, Plan M-807, designated as Parts 1-4, Plan 65R-39646, Richmond Hill;

And Whereas the *Municipal Act, 2001*, defines a lane as a highway;

And Whereas the *Municipal Act, 2001*, permits the Council of a municipality to pass by-laws for closing a highway or part of a highway;

And Whereas the Council of The Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill deems it expedient to permanently stop-up and close that portion of Aida Place more particularly described as part of Aida Place, Plan M-807, designated as Parts 1-4, Plan 65R-39646; Richmond Hill;

And Whereas public notice of Council's intention to pass this By-law was given on February 3, 2022 in accordance with the provisions of By-law 12-20;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill Enacts as Follows:

1. That portion of Aida Place more particularly described as part of Aida Place, Plan M-807, designated as Parts 1-4, Plan 65R-39646, Richmond Hill, be closed to vehicular and pedestrian traffic.
2. That a copy of this By-law be registered in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of York Region (No. 65).
