Mayor West and Members of Council,


On behalf of NEC whose lands are located in the northeast quadrant of the Bernard KDA, it remains our view that **it would be premature to endorse the above** referenced document.

Anyone who listened to the responses provided by Staff and the external consultants at the March 2 special council meeting should be able to conclude that there is no basis for preliminary findings on NEED.

More importantly it is clear from Staff that the growth projections upon which current and prior DC bylaws are premised, has not materialized.

Growth cannot pay for growth if growth does not materialize - which remains the case in Richmond Hill.
