

# The Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill

## By-Law 18-22

A By-law to amend By-law 402-89, as amended being Chapter 1116 of the City of Richmond Hill Municipal Code, relating to parking regulation.

**Whereas** on November 6th, 1989, the Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill enacted By-law No. 402-89 that regulates the parking of motor vehicles on public highways and other property (the "Parking Regulation By-law");

**And whereas** on April 13, 2022, Council of the City adopted recommendations in respect of various proposed amendments to the Parking Regulation By-law as set out in Staff Report No. SRCS.22.05 and directed staff to bring forward this by-law;

### **NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND HILL ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

That By-law No. 402-89 of the Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill (the "Parking Regulation By-law") as amended, being Chapter 1116 of the Municipal Code, be amended as follows:

The following new definition shall be added to Article 1 in alphabetical sequence:

"Non-municipal property" means land that is not a Highway and is not owned or occupied by the City and shall include private property.

Section 3.11 shall be deleted and replaced by the following:

No person shall park or leave any motor vehicle on Non-municipal property (including private property) without the consent of the owner or occupant of such property.

Section 3.12 shall be deleted and replaced by the following:

For the purposes of Section 3.11, where an owner or occupant of Non-municipal property has posted signs stating conditions on which a motor vehicle may be parked or left on the property, a motor vehicle parked or left on the Non-municipal property contrary to such conditions or prohibition shall be deemed to have been parked or left without consent.

Section 5.4 shall be deleted and replaced by the following:

In addition to any other penalty provided for in this Chapter, a Police Officer, or Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer upon written complaint of an owner or occupant of Non-municipal property, may cause a motor vehicle that is parked in contravention of this Chapter to be removed and taken to and stored in a safe place.

Except as herein provided and as required to give effect to the amendments in this By-law No. 18-22, the provisions of the Parking Regulation By-law continue in full force and effect without amendment.
