## The Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill

### By-Law 44-22

A By-law to amend By-law 69-16 of the City

Whereas on November 6<sup>th</sup>, 1989, the Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill (the “City”) enacted by-law No. 402-89 that regulates the parking of motor vehicles on public highways and other property (“Parking Regulation By-law”);

And whereas on April 13, 2022, Council of the City adopted recommendations in respect of various proposed amendments to the Parking Regulation By-law as set out in Staff Report No. SRCS.22.05;

And whereas on September 12, 2016, Council of the Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill (“City”) enacted By-law No. 69-16 establishing a system of Administrative Penalties;

And whereas amendments to the City’s AMPS By-law are necessary to enforce the revised parking offences through the City’s Administrative Monetary Penalty System;

#### **Now Therefore The Council Of The Corporation Of The City Of Richmond Hill Enacts As Follows:**

1. That By-law No. 69-16 of the Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill, as amended, be further amended by deleting Item 26 of Schedule “A” Table 1 and replacing it with Item 26 of Table 1 attached to this By-law No. 44-22
2. Except as herein provided and as required to give effect to the amendments in this By-law No. 44-22, the provisions of By-law No. 69-16 continue in full force and effect without amendment.
