3. Scheduled Business

3.1 Presentation by Gigi Li, Director, Financial Services and Treasurer, and Gary Scandlan, Watson & Associates, regarding the Community Benefits Charge - Draft Strategy

Gigi Li, Director, Financial Services and Treasurer, provided introductory remarks regarding the City's Community Benefits Charge Strategy, reviewed legislative amendments to the *Planning Act* and *Development Charges Act* as background information, and advised that Watson & Associates Economists Ltd. had been retained to undertake the City's Community Benefits Charge process and policy recommendations in collaboration with staff. She advised that the draft Strategy and By-law would be released over the next couple of weeks, and that the purpose of today's meeting was to provide background information and context to Members of Council regarding the Community Benefits Charge Strategy and By-law, as well as to give Members of Council an opportunity to provide their comments in advance of the Strategy being released. introduced Gary Scandlon, Watson & Associates Economists Ltd., who was in attendance to provide a detailed presentation regarding the City of Richmond Hill's 2022 Community Benefits Charge.

Gary Scandlon, Watson & Associates Economists Ltd., made a presentation to Council regarding the City of Richmond Hill's 2022 Community Benefits Charge (CBC). He reviewed the CBC Strategy process and timelines noting that the City was currently at Step 3; discussed funding mechanisms for growth-related capital; and provided a detailed overview of what a CBC Charge was, highlighting prior *Planning Act* legislation (Section 37), current legislation, and legislation under the new Bill 197. G. Scandlon provided an overview of the methodology of a CBC Strategy, explained the process of calculating the CBC Charge under the *Act*, and advised of factors that were to be taken into consideration including: eligible growth, land valuation, identifying the increase in need, and potential services to be considered. G. Scandlon concluded the presentation by reviewing the CBC process and advising of next steps.
