Subject: Motion by Greg Beros to rescind a council decision on Carmine Perrelli

Whereas on October 13, 2021, in connection with agenda item SRCM.21.12, Members of Council passed a resolution moved by then Councillor West and seconded by Acting Mayor DiPaola that Council requires Regional Councillor Perrelli to provide full reimbursement to the City for the Enviro Day event such that no taxpayer dollars will be used to cover the amount owing of \$139,623.30 (the "SCRM.21.12 Resolution");
