Subject: June 8 council meeting - comments for item 14.4

As a resident and taxpayer of Richmond Hill it's my understanding that I can submit comments regarding Council Meeting agenda items. As such I would like to submit the following comments regarding item 14.4: Member Motion - Councillor Beros - Regional and Local Councillor Perrelli's Enviro Day Event Exemption from the Events Policy on the June 8, 2022 Council Meeting Agenda:

- If there were errors in the staff report these need to be correct and the corrected report sent to council for acceptance. This is only fair to Councillor Perrelli. If there is money owing for the running of the event, the amount should continue to be collected by the city from the councillor's event account. The councillor should be allowed to deposit funds into the event account to clear his debt.
- If the city manager overstepped their authority when freezing the councillor's event account, this needs to be corrected. That said, the councillor should not have access to these funds to run further events until the debt owed to the city for the Enviro Day event is paid in full. Rules are rules: Councillors are responsible for funding events they sponsor; this is a well published rule that most of the other councillors and mayor seem to understand.
- If Councillor Perrelli and Councillor Beros believe they city has broken the law, then this should be resolved through the courts.
