A By-law to Amend By-law 313-96, as amended, of

Whereas the lands affected by the by-law were made subject to a Holding (H) symbol in conjunction with a zoning category, as permitted by Sections 34 and 36 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990 by By-law 313-96, as amended, of The Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill;

Whereas the Council of The Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill (the "Corporation") at its Meeting of June 22, 2022, directed that this by-law be brought forward to Council for its consideration;

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill enacts as follows:

- 1. That By-law 313-96, as amended, of the Corporation be and is hereby further amended by rezoning the lands shown on Schedule "A" from "Institutional One (I1)(H) Zone" to "Institutional One (I1) Zone".
- 2. All other provisions of By-law 313-96, as amended, not inconsistent with the foregoing, shall continue to apply to the lands shown on Schedule "A" attached hereto.
- 3. Schedule "A" attached to By-law 93-22 is declared to form a part of this by-law.

Explanatory Note to By-law 93-22

By-law 93-22 affects a portion of the lands described as Part of Lot 25, Registered Plan 169, municipally known as 49 North Lake Road.

By-law 313-96, as amended, of The Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill currently zones the subject lands "Institutional One (I1)(H) Zone". The intent of the Holding (H) symbol was to prohibit construction of a Place of Worship on the lands until an associated Site Plan application for the proposed development of the lands for a Place of Worship had received final approval from all commenting City departments and external agencies.

The condition with respect to the I1(H) Zone restriction has been satisfied and By-law 93-22 removes the Holding (H) symbol from the zoning of the lands.
