

The Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill

By-Law 107-22

A By-Law to establish the composition of the Richmond Hill
Public Library Board

Whereas under subsection 9(1) of the *Public Libraries Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.44, as amended (hereinafter the “Act”), a public library board shall be composed of at least five members appointed by the municipal council;

And Whereas subsection 10(1) of the Act sets out the qualifications of persons appointed to a Library Board;

And Whereas clause 10(2)(a) of the Act provides that the appointing municipal council shall not appoint more of its own member to a Library Board than the number that is one less than a majority of the board;

And Whereas Richmond Hill Council at its meeting on June 22, 2022 adopted recommendations contained in Staff Report SRCFS.22.001 to establish the composition of the Richmond Hill Public Library Board beginning at the start of the 2022 to 2026 Term of Council;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill Enacts as Follows:

1. That the Richmond Hill Public Library Board shall be comprised of a total of nine (9) members appointed by Richmond Hill Council as follows:
 - (a) three (3) Members of Council; and
 - (b) six (6) other persons who are qualified to be appointed in accordance with the provisions of subsection 10(1) of the *Public Libraries Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.44, as amended, including persons who are permanent residents within the meaning of the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act* (Canada) notwithstanding any other by-law or policy to the contrary.
2. That this by-law shall come into full force and effect on November 15, 2022
