I have read the application of Regional and Local Councillor Mr. Perrelli. While my opinion does not matter, the arguments put forth by Mr. Perrelli makes zero sense. The video of the council proceedings for May 5, 2021, will show that Mr. Perrelli clearly asked that his Enviro event be exempt from the new rules and the old policy does require a councillor to fund their own events.
