A By-law to Amend By-law 69-16 of the City of Richmond Hill

Whereas on November 6th, 1989, the Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill (the "City") enacted By-law 402-89 that regulates the parking of motor vehicles on public highways and other property ("Parking Regulation By-law");

And Whereas on February 8, 2023, Council of the City adopted recommendations in respect of various proposed amendments to the Parking Regulation By-law as set out in Staff Report SRPI.23.016;

And Whereas on September 12, 2016, Council of the Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill ("City") enacted By-law 69-16 establishing a system of Administrative Penalties:

And Whereas amendments to the City's AMPS By-law are necessary to enforce the revised parking offences through the City's Administrative Monetary Penalty System;

Now Therefore The Council of The Corporation of The City Of Richmond Hill Enacts as Follows:

1. That the following Item 33 be added to Table 1 of Schedule "A" of the Administrative Penalty By-law (By-law 69-16):
