2. Disclosures of Pecuniary Interest and General Nature Thereof

There were no disclosures of pecuniary interest by Members of Council under the *Municipal Conflict of Interest Act*.

3. Scheduled Business

3.1 2023 Development Charges Background Study and By-law Update

Gigi Li, Director of Financial Services and Treasurer, provided introductory remarks regarding the 2023 Development Charges (DC) Background Study and By-law Update. She advised that the Study was a critical undertaking for the City's financial planning framework and development related funding, noted that extensive stakeholder consultations had taken place, and that staff had been working with the consultant Watson & Associates Economists Ltd. G. Li advised that this was the first comprehensive DC update since 2014, as well as the City's first update post-Bill 23, *More Homes Built Faster Act, 2022*, and noted that a

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preliminary staff report was presented to Council in June 2023 that outlined the process and adoption date. She acknowledged staff's efforts to incorporate a number of changes and impacts, as well as extra measures to ensure realistic construction costs were integrated into the Study's framework, and introduced Gary Scandlan, Watson & Associates Economists Ltd. who would be making a presentation.

- G. Scandlan, Watson & Associates Economists Ltd., made a presentation to Council regarding the 2023 Development Charges (DC) Background Study and By-law Update. He provided an overview of the process and timelines, reviewed the municipal financial planning framework and explained the process for the City's Plans and Studies. He reviewed the purpose and history of DCs, changes to the DC legislation and to the *Development Charges Act*, methodology and calculation of DCs, 10 and 20 year growth forecasts, and the draft service standards and capital project listing.
- G. Scandlan further reviewed the draft DC rates by municipal wide services/class of service for residential and non-residential units, rate comparisons of current, calculated and 5 year mandatory phase-in DC charges for a series of residential and non-residential units, and provided DC comparisons with neighbouring municipalities for residential and non-residential unit types. He also reviewed local service policies, Area Specific Development Charges, other DC policies, and concluded the presentation by outlining next steps.
