I am writing to you to inquire clarity on a mentioned item from the 1st agenda item related to the Ivylea/Marlin Springs Development. The building commission had mentioned that there has been no processing delays from the municipal and pointed out that there was a delay caused by the applicant because they purchased additional lands to be part of the site. I would like to understand what duration of delay did this cause?

I am certain others have expressed this already, but the applicant have consistently mention that the delays are because of municipal/city and it is "out of their control".

Furthermore, I want to express my personal experience as I am one of the homeowners of Ivylea. Similar to many others, I am under extreme financial duress resulting from unbelievably high, and prolonged fees from closing time. To further accentuate the problem, the build quality is poor and is a poor representation of the city of Richmond Hill.

Despite the dissatisfaction, I took occupancy and paid the fees on time as I am just a "normal simpleton". Over the course of the months, I had seek clarifications on closing, but they fail to respond. To pay for such astronomical fees, I had to take a second job with very extended hours. I have lost significant weight and other health issues leading to major concerns by friends and family that now I am seeking medical attention for.

I am writing this to plead support from the council in support the resolution of this matter.
