Hello. I live at 100 Elgin Mills West Unit 18 and I have expressed the following concerns with the proposed development.

1. The additional traffic load onto Dickson warrants a light especially if the fiture plan is to widen Elgin Mills West to 2 full lanes. Currently, it is very challenging to make a left turn onto Elgin Mills from our development, especially during rush hours. The additional vehicular traffic load of the proposed development and future developments will only exacerbate the situation. If the Town doesn't want to pay for a traffic light then make the developer pay.
