By-Law 40-25

A By-Law to amend Procurement By-law 113-16, as amended

Whereas on December 12, 2016, the Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill (the "Corporation") enacted By-law 113-16 with respect to a procurement policy (the "Procurement By-law");

And Whereas on November 25, 2020, the Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill (the "Corporation") enacted By-law 141-20, a By-law to amend Procurement By-law 113-16 and Financial Control By-law 114-16;

And Whereas on February 26, 2025, Council of the City of Richmond Hill adopted the recommendations set out in staff report SRCFS.25.007 and authorized the City Clerk to include any by-laws required to amend the City's Procurement By-law with respect to modifying current procurement practices to give effect to prioritizing Canadian goods and services.

Now Therefore The Council Of The Corporation Of The City Of Richmond Hill Enacts As Follows:

1. That the Procurement By-law be further amended as follows:
 - a. Appendix "A" shall be amended by:
 - i. Deleting and replacing the definition of "Medium Value Acquisition" with the following:

"Medium Value Acquisition" means an Acquisition having an Acquisition Value that is twenty-five thousand (\$25,000) dollars or greater but less than one-hundred thirty thousand eight hundred (\$133,800) dollars."
 - ii. Deleting and replacing the definition of "High Value Acquisition" with the following.

"High Value Acquisition" means an Acquisition of Goods or Services having an estimated Acquisition Value of one-hundred thirty thousand eight hundred (\$133,800) dollars or greater."
