By-Law 48-25

A by-law to amend By-law No. 69-16 of the City

Whereas on February 11, 2019, Council of the Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill ("Council") enacted an amendment to the Administrative Penalty By-law No. 69-16 that established an Administrative Monetary Penalty System ("AMPS") for parking infractions, to expand AMPS so that it may also apply to promote compliance with any by-law passed pursuant to the Municipal Act, 2001;

And whereas on April 23, 2025 Council of the City adopted the recommendations of Staff Report No. SRPBS.25.0.25 to enact a new by-law for the regulation of Tree Preservation (the "Tree Preservation By-law") and to add such by-law as a designated by-law to By-law No. 69-16 so that the Tree Preservation By-law may be enforced using AMPS;

Now Therefore The Council Of The Corporation Of The City Of Richmond Hill Enacts As Follows:

1. **That Schedule 'A' of By-law No. 69-16 of the Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill**, as amended, be further amended by adding Table 11 attached to this By-law No. 48-25;
2. Except as herein provided and as required to give effect to the amendments in this By-law No. 48-25, the provisions of By-law No. 69-16 continue in full force and effect without amendment.
