As a resident of Oak Ridges for 44 years, I oppose the construction of this due to all the reasons below. 🗣️ Oak Ridges Speak Out to Protect Our Neighbourhood!

A new development is proposed for 13564 & 13580 Yonge St and 40 Coons Rd — including an 8-storey building, townhomes, 285 units and 2 levels of underground parking.

🕒 Why this matters:

- Too Big – Exceeds city height (max 6 storeys) & density limits (nearly double allowed FSI of 2)
- No Shops – No required commercial space along Yonge
- Traffic Concerns – 285 units = more congestion & safety issues
- Environmental Risk – Near protected lands & high aquifer vulnerability
- Lacks Affordability – Only 10% affordable housing (policy requires 25%)
- This is not a Major Transit Station Area (MTSA)
