### 6. Scheduled Business

# 6.1 Presentation by Mojgan Rasouli, Policy Planner II, regarding the Official Plan Update: Accessibility and Barrier-Free Policies

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Mojgan Rasouli, Policy Planner II, made a presentation to Committee regarding proposed updates to the City's Official Plan (OP) to reinforce accessibility and barrier-free planning policies. She noted that these updates are part of a required provincial and regional conformity exercise and emphasized the importance of aligning with the *Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act* (AODA). She outlined the current planning framework, the status of the Official Plan update, and proposed policy enhancements. Key updates included stronger language in policy wording, expanded application of accessibility standards, and enhanced direction for the design of public spaces. M. Rasouli concluded the presentation by highlighting next steps in the update process, including upcoming public engagement sessions and timelines for draft amendments.

Committee members extended thanks for the presentation and requested clarification on the accessibility standards applied to new park developments as well as the City's plans to retrofit older parks to meet those standards. Committee suggested adding signage in parks and buildings to indicate AODA compliance and City contact information, and emphasized the need to go beyond standard public consultations by engaging with disability-focused organizations and experts with lived experience. They also inquired about the inclusion of sustainability in the OP, expressed support for the strengthened policy language, and requested that the registration link for the upcoming engagement sessions be shared with all committee members.

# 6.2 Presentation by Sherry Caldwell, Richmond Hill Accessibility Advisory Committee Member, regarding Red Shirt Day and National AccessAbility Week Conference hosted by York Region

Sherry Caldwell, Richmond Hill Accessibility Advisory Committee Member, provided a verbal update to Committee regarding the upcoming Red Shirt Day and National AccessAbility Week conference, which will be hosted by York Region on May 28, 2025, from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., in Newmarket. She highlighted that the conference would commemorate the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the *Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act* 

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(AODA) and celebrate Easter Seals Ontario's Red Shirt Day of Action for accessibility and inclusion. Committee member Caldwell encouraged all members to attend, and outlined the event's key highlights including keynote speakers, as well as an extended Question and Answer session to promote community advocacy.

Committee members expressed gratitude for the shared information and recognized Committee member Caldwell's advocacy and commitment to improving accessibility for all. It was requested that the Clerk's Office forward the invitation to all Committee members once received from York Region.
