

The Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill

By-Law 91-25

A by-law to amend By-law No. 69-16, being the City of Richmond Hill Administrative Penalty By-law.

Whereas on February 11, 2019, Council of the Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill (“Council”) enacted an amendment to the Administrative Penalty By-law No. 69-16 that established an Administrative Monetary Penalty System (“AMPS”) for parking infractions, to expand AMPS so that it may also apply to promote compliance with any by-law passed pursuant to the Municipal Act, 2001;

And whereas on September 24, 2025 Council adopted the recommendations of Staff Report SRIES.25.006, to enact a new by-law for the regulation of micromobility devices being the Active Transportation and Micromobility By-law No. 90-25, and to add this By-law as a designated by-law to the City’s Administrative Penalty By-law No. 69-16, so that violations of the Active Transportation and Micromobility By-law may be enforced using AMPS;

Now Therefore The Council Of The Corporation Of The City Of Richmond Hill Enacts As Follows:

1. That Schedule ‘A’ of the Administrative Penalty By-law No. 69-16, as amended, of the Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill, be further amended by adding Table 15 attached to this By-law No. 91-25;
2. Except as herein provided and as required to give effect to the amendments in this By-law No. 91-25, the provisions of the Administrative Penalty By-law No. 69-16 continue in full force and effect without amendment.
