I agree with your position and I also oppose the introduction of the proposed parking restrictions on Arnold Crescent. As you mentioned, the City had previously indicated that no changes to parking regulations were planned, and this sudden shift — especially during a long construction period — feels unnecessary and inconsistent with what residents were told.

Street parking is important for guests and day-to-day convenience, and I also don't believe removing parking is the right way to address safety concerns. Measures like reduced speed limits or traffic-calming features would make far more sense without creating additional challenges for residents.
