By-Law 154-25

A By-law to amend By-law 69-16, being the City of Richmond Hill
Administrative Penalty By-law

Whereas on February 11, 2019, Council of the Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill (“Council”) enacted an amendment to the Administrative Penalty By-law 69-16 that established an Administrative Monetary Penalty System (“AMPS”) for parking infractions, to expand AMPS so that it may also apply to promote compliance with any by-law passed pursuant to the *Municipal Act, 2001*;

And Whereas on December 10, 2025, Council adopted the recommendations of Staff Report SRIES.25.013 in respect of various proposed amendments to the Parking Regulation By-law 402-89, Municipal Code Chapter 1116 and the Administrative Penalty By-law 69-16, as amended;

Now Therefore The Council Of The Corporation Of The City Of Richmond Hill Enacts As Follows:

1. That the following Items 34 through 37 be added to Table 1 of Schedule ‘A’ of the Administrative Penalty By-law 69-16, as amended as follows:

34	1116.5.1 (a)	park/stop Motor Vehicle in designated electric vehicle charging space	\$125.00
35	1116.5.1 (b)	park/stop Electric Vehicle in charging space unless charging	\$125.00
36	1116.5.1 (c)	park Electric Vehicle in charging space for more than ten hours	\$125.00
37	1116.5.3 (a)	Fail to pay all applicable user fees	\$125.00

2. Except as herein provided and as required to give effect to the amendments in this By-law No. 154-25, the provisions of the Administrative Penalty By-law No. 69-16 continue in full force and effect without amendment.
