

# The Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill

## By-Law 155-25

A By-law to amend By-law 69-16, being the City of Richmond Hill  
Administrative Penalty By-law

Whereas on February 11, 2019, Council of the Corporation of the City of Richmond Hill (“Council”) enacted an amendment to the Administrative Penalty By-law 69-16 that established an Administrative Monetary Penalty System (“AMPS”) for parking infractions, to expand AMPS so that it may also apply to promote compliance with any by-law passed pursuant to the *Municipal Act, 2001*;

And whereas on December 10, 2025 Council adopted the recommendations of Staff Report SRIES.25.013 in respect of various proposed amendments to the Park Use By-law 19-22 and the Administrative Penalty By-law 69-16;

### Now Therefore The Council Of The Corporation Of The City Of Richmond Hill Enacts As Follows:

1. That Table 8 of Schedule “A” of the Administrative Penalty By-law 69-16 be amended by deleting Item 39.
2. That the following Items 39 through 41 be added to Table 8 of Schedule ‘A’ of the Administrative Penalty By-law 69-16, as amended and all Items be renumbered accordingly:

Column 1 Item	Column 2 Designated Provisions	Column 3 Short Form Wording	Column 4 Administrative Penalty Amount
39	3.8 a)	Park Motor Vehicle in Parking Area beyond Park hours	\$50
40	3.8 b)	Park Motor Vehicle not in accordance with Permit	\$50
41	3.8 c)	Park Electric Vehicle not Actively Charging or in a Charging Session	\$125

3. Except as herein provided and as required to give effect to the amendments in this By-law No. 155-25, the provisions of the Administrative Penalty By-law No. 69-16 continue in full force and effect without amendment.
